I'm still a bit of a daredevil and that won't change. I have my share of life stories and experiences, and I am going to make so many more!

It's one of the things that has kept me sane, I spend a lot of time on the computer doing work, keeping in contact with friends and family, or just playing games, and sometimes when the weather is nice I like to go to the park or hang out outside.

I have my own van and one thing I would need you to be able to do while you are working with me is driving me around.

Some of the tasks that I need done (depending on the shift) and would need you able to do would be:

- Diabetes care
- Turning and re-positioning
- Single person transfer from bed to wheelchair or vice versa (with a ceiling lift)
- Medications
- Trach suctioning
- Light housework
- Meal preparation and feeding
- Personal hygiene

All of the things I've listed and any I have forgotten I am willing to teach you because then I can teach you how to do them the way I like them done.

I'm currently in need of one registered nurse to work Saturday and Sunday 8 AM – 8 PM. Get a hold of me for more specifics on what the shifts are as well as the wages.

I am currently in need of a full-time caregiver as an IP through the state.
