Getting to know Access

Access Is:

- King County METRO's ADA para-transit service.
- Available on the same days, during the same times, in the same areas as noncommuter, regular bus service.
- For people who have a disability that prevents use of the regular bus system either some or all of the time.
- A shared ride. This means others may get on or off before you are dropped off at your destination.
- \$1.25 per passenger per one-way trip (approved personal care attendants ride free).
- Capable of taking clients to locations other than (in addition to) medical appointments.

Access Is Not:

- Medical Transportation
- A "same day" ride (schedule 1-3 days in advance)
- Always the only or fastest option
- Faster than the bus. A ride can take as long or longer depending on the route.
- Able to change route during a trip (you can request changes before 4:30 pm the day before).
