During your time in the lab, an Occupational or Speech therapist can evaluate your needs, discuss options and resources available, and provide training in the following areas:

- Computer, Tablet, & Phone Access
- Electronic Aids for Daily Living (EADLs)/Smart Home Technology
- Adaptive Gaming
- Voice Recognition Training
- Augmentative/Alternative Communication Systems (AAC)
